Individual Sports

1. Use the official 1996 Aloha State Games Individual Entry Form tear-out on page 9. Complete all information in Section One.
2. In the Sports Registration section, print the name of the sport you are entering. (Only one sport per entry form. Make more copies of form as needed for number of sports you are entering.)
3. Using the sports information starting on page 13, fill in the Entry Code for your division, event and gender. For example, if you are a 16-year-old male competing in the Compound Bow Unlimited event in Archery, you would enter AR307.
4. Print the division and event you are entering next to the Entry Code. Provide any additional information requested in the Specific Sport Information section.
5. Sign the release/waiver on the back of the entry form. A parent or guardian must sign for anyone under 18 years old. Unsigned waivers will not be accepted.
6. Send the completed entry form/signed waiver and the appropriate entry fees to the Aloha State Games, 1110 University Ave., Suite 403, Honolulu, HI 96826-1508. Golfers be sure to include the green, cart and banquet fees. Competitors participating in more than one event in a sport, please remember to include \$2 per additional event (see page 4 for more details).

Team Sports

1. Use the official 1996 Aloha State Games Team Entry Form tear-out on page 11. The contact person should complete all information in Section One. All teams should include an alternate team name on the entry form. Team names will be credited to the team that registers first. If an alternate name is not included and your first choice is already taken, your team will be assigned a name.
2. Print the name of the sport your team is entering (only one sport per Team Entry Form). Using the sports information starting on page 13, fill in the corresponding Entry Code for your division and event.
3. Complete the Team Roster section, including all information requested. Be sure to adhere to the maximum number of participants listed.
4. Sign the release/waiver. A parent or guardian must sign for anyone under 18 years old. Have all members sign a copy of the waiver.
