On January 24th a meeting was held to discuss our progress on wheel-to-wheel racing. Everything is on schedule and we will be racing this spring. Our first event will be a drivers school at Hawaii Raceway Park. The weekend school will include classroom training on Saturday and three or more hours of on-track instruction on Sunday. The drivers school will conclude with a practice race so that all of the students will have a chance to make use of their newly acquired racing skills. A second drivers school will be scheduled this summer and a regional race this fall.

I'd once again like to encourage any of you who would like to participate, but have not yet purchased a car, to consider an improved touring car. This is probably the least expensive approach and if we concentrate our efforts on a few classes, we'll have more exciting racing. At this point in time the ITS class seems to have the most drivers.

We also need workers. The best way to find out if you'd like to race in the future is to work an event. You'll find out that working can be a great experience and a lot of fun.
