### SOLO I RULES

The next Solo I event is being scheduled for August 22nd at HRP. If you are considering running in Solo I you are urged to contact Peter Chung for all the details. In brief here are the major safety rules. Any car is legal provided:

- -It has a roll bar (next year it must have a roll cage) -The driver is wearing a 5 point harness
- -VR or HR rated tires are used on the fast courses. Street tires are OK but are limited to 5 minutes on the track.
- -The driver is wearing a Snell 80 rated helmet and a Nomex driving suit (including gloves and driving boots or Nomex socks)
- -There is a fire extinguisher on board (next year the fire control system must be of the plumbed type)
