

S C C A DRIVERS' INFORMATION

The possibility of wheel-to-wheel SCCA racing in Hawaii has been discussed for several years. We now have a chance to organize a racing series, but only if we have enough interested drivers. SCCA has many rules and regulations and we must comply with all of them or we will not get insurance for the race. This outline should answer your basic questions on cost and what will be required of you to become a licensed SCCA driver. Please remember that the cost figures are only estimates and apply to a minimal car. If you want to win races, it will probably cost much more.

**SCCA REGIONAL DRIVER'S LICENSE REQUIREMENTS:**

| Racing                    | You must complete two SCCA regional races within two years of the date your permit was issued.   |
| The Car                   | <p>All cars running in SCCA races must be in safe mechanical condition and pass a detailed technical inspection. The following items are also necessary on all Improved Touring cars.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Full Roll Cage.</li> <li>2. Fire Extinguisher.</li> <li>3. Catch Tanks.</li> <li>4. Master "Kill" Switch.</li> <li>5. Scattershield or Explosion-proof Bell housing.</li> <li>6. Window Safety Net.</li> <li>7. Five or Six Point Drivers Restraint Harness.</li> <li>8. All Required Numbers, Decals and SCCA Logos.</li> </ol> |
