Story said roller hockey has drawn a big response again this year after making its debut in last summer's games. He suggested that teams which haven't registered yet do so soon.

"It was an absolute success last year," Story said. "I wish we could have more teams, but we've only one venue. We're not full yet, but it's getting close."

Registration booklets were first available April 7. The tentative deadline to sign up is May 20.

"But if individual sport commissioners think they can take more, we will keep registration open for those sports," Story said. "Then there's surfing; that's a walk-up sport. We don't want people having to commit \$20 in case the meet's canceled because there's no surf. The state games are all about volunteers and giving the community what it wants."
