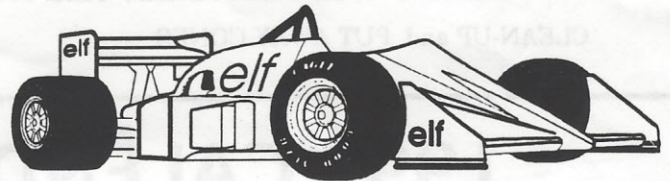
From the RE's Desk
