

The September Solo II at TH3 saw the tightening of competition for the 1982 Championship. The run off is in November and in some of the classes the competition is hot and heavy. Fortunately, the weather for the 9/12 event was perfect - only a couple drops of rain.

As has been the case in recent months, Jaije Wong in his Toyota Trueno racer had the fastest time of the day on a relatively wide open course. Peter Chung, also driving a Toyota, was number two closely followed by Pat Lawrence in his As Porsche and Robert Vincent in his Corvette (Em). Fifth overall was last months FTD driver, Curtis Lee, in his Cs 240Z.

The Triumph Club was given the first shot at the course. The club brought its own video taping crew to tape the event. John Shrum in his Triumph TR6 was able to triumph over Tom Coughlin (GT6) and Mark Ratcliffe (TR6) to take Ds honors. Linda Shaw likewise triumphed over Janice Brauner in Es1, both driving Spitfires. Triumph Club member S.J. Sims (Fiat) took first place in Es over Rick DuVoisin's Alpine.

The As class had its usual close racing. Pat Lawrence took first with Ed Higa and Jim Moe closely following (all Porsches). Dp had five entrants with Peter Chung and Keith Yamanaka (VW Scirocco) again finishing in the top two places. Robert Iriye turned in his usual smooth driving to win Gs, beating out Leon Seto and Dennis Tomasu (both VW Scirocco). Finally, in the Em class Robert Vincent turned back the Challenges of Mike Renfro (RX7) and Bruce Adams (911T). Poor Bruce broke his transmission and was only able to complete one circuit on the course.

At the noon break trophies for the July and August events were awarded. At the October event (at Aloha Stadium) the trophies for September will be handed out at noon. See you there.
